

ORDINANCE # 19

The Town Board of the Town of Troy does hereby  
ordain as follows:

SECTION I. No holder of a class B fermented malt beverage or intoxicating liquor license shall employ or allow to perform on the premises any entertainer except when such entertainer is a member of a band, a vocalist, a piano or organ player or comedian, and in any event such entertainer shall be fully clothed in such a manner as is acceptable in all public places. No such licensee shall allow any entertainment which shall make an appeal to prurient interest.

SECTION II. There shall be no dancing either with customers or by themselves of any employees of the owner of any premises operating under a class B fermented malt beverage or liquor license.

SECTION III. Dancing by customers in any premises licensed by a class B fermented malt or intoxicating liquor license shall be confined to a dancing area segregated and approved as to location by the Fire Chief.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

SECTION V. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) together with the costs of prosecution for each offense, and in default of such forfeiture and costs of the prosecution shall be imprisoned in the county jail until such forfeiture and costs shall be paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.
