## Ordinance # 97-3

An Ordinance to regulate any request that the Troy Center Fire Department destroy by fire the buildings presently located upon said premises.

The Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section I: Any person making a request that the Troy Center Fire Dept. destroy by fire the buildings presently located upon said premises, must meet the following requirements:

1. That said person must be the owner of the premises and the buildings thereon.
2. That said person states that there are no outstanding mortgages or other liens against the said premises and buildings.
3. That said person has merchantable and clear title to said premises and building;
4. That said person has authority to make such a request and warrants that said building is free of insurance coverage at the time said building is to be destroyed by fire.


Section II. That any such request received by the Troy Center Fire Dept. shall be referred and forwarded to Gateway Technical College for their use in a fire fighting training exercise.

Section III. That the Troy Center Fire Dept. and the Town of Troy are hereby released from any and all damages and/or claims as a result of the destruction of said building.

Section IV. There may be an exception to this ordinance whereby the Troy Center Fire Department requests from the Town Board that they be allowed to destroy a specific premise without the assistance of Gateway Technical College. The purpose of this exception would be to allow Troy Center Fire Department to perform a training exercise exclusively with its members.

Section V. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and posting according to law.
