ORDINANCE 2020-1

AN ORDINANCE REPEAL AND RE-CREATE TOWN OF TROY
ORDINANCE 2010-2 TO ESTABLISH SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTION
OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under §7.30(1)(a) Wis. Stats. to allow for two or more sets of election officials to work on election days; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 10, 2010, the Town of Troy adopted Ordinance 2010-2 pursuant to such statutory authority, to create two shifts of election workers on election day, which would commence at 6 a.m. and 1 p.m., respectively, and the Town of Troy now wishes to revise these split shifts so that they commence at 6:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m., respectively; and

WHEREAS, to allow for efficient and appropriate administration of elections in the Town of Troy, the Town Board hereby intends to adopt such statutory authority, and to amend the times for such split shifts as described herein.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: There shall be two shifts for election workers on election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with the completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls as directed by the Town Clerk.

SECTION 2: Town of Troy Ordinance 2010-2 entitled, "Ordinance Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials," adopted on or about March 10, 2010, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under § 60.80, Wis. Stats.
