ORDINANCE NO. 2019-3

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE STOP SIGNS ON TOWNLINE ROAD AT THE INTERSECTION OF TOWNLINE ROAD AND THE BOOTH LAKE PUBLIC ACCESS DRIVEWAY AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Troy has the authority to adopt traffic regulations pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 349.06, in strict conformity with State traffic statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes Section 346.46 requires vehicles to stop at stop signs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board finds that the public safety requires stop signs to be installed on Townline Road at the intersection of Townline Road and the Booth Lake parking area, where vehicles and pedestrians enter and cross Townline Road; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Troy hereby establishes stopping requirements as follows.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Operators of vehicles travelling in either direction shall stop at the posted stop signs in accordance with Sections 346.04(2) and 346.46, Wisconsin Statutes on Townline Road at the vehicle and pedestrian intersection with the Booth lake beach and boat launch public access.

SECTION 2: The Town of Troy Public Works Supervisor is authorized and directed to post official signs giving notice of the foregoing obligation, in the form and manner required by Section 349.065, Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3: Violations of this ordinance are subject to the forfeitures established for the comparable State offenses, including any variations or increases for second offenses as listed in the Revised Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
