

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-3

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBIT PARKING AT THE TROY CENTER FIRE DEPARTMENT WATER ACCESS POINT ON TOWNLINE ROAD AT PICKEREL CREEK

WHEREAS, the Troy Center Fire Department Fire Chief has advised the Town Board that they rely upon the creek that connects to Pickerel Lake, where it crosses beneath Townline Road, as a water access point, to draw water to fight fires in the vicinity of the Town of Troy; and

WHEREAS, the Troy Center Fire Department must have unimpeded access to the water access point for the health, safety and welfare of the Town and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Troy hereby intends to prohibit parking in such area of Townline Road, therefore, as follows.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: NO PARKING. Parking is prohibited where no parking signs are posted on Townline Road in the vicinity of the creek that passes beneath Townline Road, that connects to Pickerel Creek.

SECTION 2: SIGNAGE. The Town Supervisor of Public Works is authorized and directed to post signs to prohibit parking as prohibited by this ordinance.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES. The Penalty for violations of any provisions of this Code shall be a forfeiture as hereafter provided together with costs under Sec. 345.20, Wis. Stats.

(a) FORFEITURES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS.

- (1) UNIFORM STATEWIDE OFFENSES. The minimum and maximum forfeitures for violations of the offenses described in Wisconsin Statutes Section 346.52(1)(h) shall be not less than \$20 nor more than \$40 for the first offense and not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for the 2nd or subsequent conviction within a year, plus court costs and the costs of prosecution.
- (2) OTHER PARKING OFFENSES. The penalty for all other parking violations not included in paragraph (1) above shall be a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 dollars nor more than \$100.00 dollars, plus court costs and the costs of prosecution.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under § 60.80, Wis. Stats.
